The family is so thankful for all of the community's support along the way, and are excited to have everyone visit and enjoy the new space. They look forward to sharing the new space, the family story, and their passion for fine wines with you.


Airy Acres Vineyard has been a family farm since 1918. Once the site of the largest chicken farm in Seneca County and still the home of a working grass runway called Airy Acres Airport, the Bassette family repurposed the land as a vineyard in 2015. They now grow eight different varietals on 21 acres with room for development in the future. Their first vintages were Riesling and Cabernet Franc in 2020, and now they offer 13 different wines solely made from fruit from the 21-acre vineyard using Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Chardonnay, Rkatsiteli, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Lemberger, and Saperavi.

At Airy Acres Vineyard, they pride themselves on their dedication to producing high-quality wines. The vineyard is a family-owned business, and every bottle they produce is a testament to their commitment to quality and their love for winemaking.
